## Amazing What We Can Learn At Lunch

### 1. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ With Pharisees.

Luke 14:1 One Sabbath, when Jesus went to eat in the house of a prominent Pharisee, he was being carefully watched.

Luke 14:2 There in front of him was a man suffering from abnormal swelling of his body. 3 Jesus asked the Pharisees and experts in the law, “Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath or not?” 4 But they remained silent. So taking hold of the man, he healed him and sent him on his way.

Luke 14:5 Then he asked them, “If one of you has a child or an ox that falls into a well on the Sabbath day, will you not immediately pull it out?” 6 And they had nothing to say.

Luke 14:7 When he noticed how the guests picked the places of honor at the table,

Luke 14:7 he told them this parable: 8 “When someone invites you to a wedding feast, do not take the place of honor, for a person more distinguished than you may have been invited.

### 6. Jesus Says Stop Pride From \_\_\_\_\_ Life.

Luke 14:9 If so, the host who invited both of you will come and say to you, ‘Give this person your seat.’ Then, humiliated, you will have to take the least important place.

### 7. Jesus Tells Us What We \_\_\_\_\_ To Do.

Luke 14:10 But when you are invited, take the lowest place, so that when your host comes, he will say to you, ‘Friend, move up to a better place.’ Then you will be honored in the presence of all the other guests.

### 8. Jesus Places A \_\_\_\_\_ Value on Humility.

Luke 14:11 For all those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.”
