John 19:23 When the soldiers crucified Jesus, they took his clothes, dividing them into four shares, one for each of them, with the undergarment remaining. This garment was seamless, woven in one piece from top to bottom. 24 "Let's not tear it," they said to one another. "Let's decide by lot who will get it." This happened that the scripture might be fulfilled that said, "They divided my clothes among them and cast lots for my garment." So this is what the soldiers did.

8. Jesus Care For His Mom To John.

John 19:25 Near the cross of Jesus stood his mother, his mother's sister, Mary the wife of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene. 26 When Jesus saw his mother there, and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to her, "Woman, here is your son," 27 and to the disciple, "Here is your mother." From that time on, this disciple took her into his home.

9. Jesus Is \_\_\_\_\_ By The People Present.

Matt 27:39 Those who passed by hurled insults at him, shaking their heads 40 and saying, "You who are going to destroy the temple and build it in three days, save yourself! Come down from the cross, if you are the Son of God!" 41 In the same way the chief priests, the teachers of the law and the elders mocked him. 42 "He saved others," they said, "but he can't save himself! He's the king of Israel! Let him come down now from the cross, and we will believe in him. 43 He trusts in God. Let God rescue him now if he wants him, for he said, 'I am the Son of God."" Luke 23:35 The people stood watching, and the rulers even sneered at him. They said, "He saved others; let him save himself if he is God's Messiah, the Chosen One."

10. Nailed Robbers Verbally \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus. Matt 27:44 In the same way the rebels who were crucified with him also heaped insults on him. Luke 23:39 One of the criminals who hung there hurled insults at him: "Aren't you the Messiah? Save yourself and us!"

11. One Robber \_\_\_\_\_ *Up* For Jesus. Luke 23:40 But the other criminal rebuked him.

"Don't you fear God," he said, "since you are under the same sentence? 41 We are punished justly, for we are getting what our deeds deserve. But this man has done nothing wrong."

12. Robber \_\_\_\_\_ And \_\_\_\_ For Help. Luke 23:42 Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."

13. Jesus Announces Robbers \_\_\_\_\_ In Heaven. Luke 23:43 Jesus answered him, "Truly I tell you, today you will be with me in paradise."
