(4) The dead are resurrected suddenly.

1. All unbelievers from the past come alive.

2. The great \& small - Everyone.

The second resurrection:
(1) All who died in the sea throughout history.

## 3. Judgment moves to the next level.

(1) Books are opened.

(2) Records are kept - Facts matter.

(3) Their deeds condemn them - Clearly.

Rev 20:13 $\ldots$ and each person was judged according to what they had done.
4. The sentence is handed down.
(1) The guilty are placed in the Lake of Fire.

Rev 20:14 Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire.
(2) A second death is experienced by unbelievers.

Rev 20:14 . . The lake of fire is the second death.
(3) Ultimately the Book of Life is necessary.
